Kenyan Safari - Sum 2026

7Nights 8Days



Day 1 : Welcome to Nairobi.

Welcome to Nairobi - the capital and largest city of Kenya. On arrival, proceed to your conveniently located hotel. (Check-in after 15:00) The rest of the day allows you to unwind after your journey, settling into the rhythm of Kenya's capital city. Overnight in Nairobi.

Day 2 : Onto Amboseli National Park

Today morning proceed towards the famed Amboseli National Park, passing through the dramatic landscapes of Kenya's Rift Valley Province. As you approach Amboseli, the scenery shifts to open savannahs dominated by acacia woodlands. After lunch, a half-day game drive reveals Amboseli's thriving wildlife—elephants, giraffes, zebras, and possibly big cats—set against the majestic backdrop of Mount Kilimanjaro. A photo stop is made at a viewpoint where the snow-capped peak often appears floating above the clouds. Overnight in Amboseli.

Day 3 : Full Day in Amboseli – Dawn & Sunset at Kilimanjaro

At dawn you venture into the park when light mist lifts to reveal a postcard-perfect silhouette of Mount Kilimanjaro. The full-day game drive allows you to explore Amboseli's marshlands, dusty plains, and elephant corridors at leisure. A jungle picnic lunch is enjoyed beneath the shade of acacias while wildlife roams freely in the distance. The day slowly fades into a breathtaking orange-gold sunset with the mountain glowing behind the horizon. Overnight in Amboseli.

Day 4 : Amboseli – Great Rift Valley – Lake Elementaita

Today's journey ascends the escarpments of the Great Rift Valley, showcasing sweeping views of volcanic formations and shimmering lakes below. En-route, you enjoy lunch before arriving at Lake Naivasha for a serene boat ride where hippos bob in the water and fish eagles soar overhead. Continuing towards Lake Elementaita, as you pass countryside dotted with farms and small towns to reach your lodge. Overnight in Lake Elementaita area.

Day 5 : Exploring Lake Nakuru National Park

Make your way to the iconic Lake Nakuru National Park, known for its rhinos, lions, buffalos, and the mirror-like lake that often attracts flamingos. The day unfolds through lush woodlands, sweeping savannahs, and lakeside viewpoints. Lunch is enjoyed either in the park or back at your lodge, and the evening offers quiet time by the shores of Elementaita. Overnight in Lake Elementaita area.

Day 6 : Elementaita – Masai Mara

Today heads west toward the legendary Masai Mara. Along the way you stop at Narok Town, a vibrant cultural and trading hub, for lunch and an opportunity to stretch and browse local craft stalls. Upon entering the Mara, the wildlife becomes immediately visible as you enjoy an evening game drive. Visit a traditional Maasai village where you learn about their customs, dance, and daily life. Overnight in Masai Mara.

Day 7 : Full Day Safari in Masai Mara – Hipo Pool

The day begins with a sunrise game drive across golden plains alive with predators, grazers, and birdlife. The Mara's sprawling landscape makes each wildlife encounter unique. A picnic lunch is enjoyed in the wild before you continue toward the Hipo Pool near the Tanzania border, where hippos wallow and crocodiles bask along the Mara River. Overnight in Masai Mara.

Day 8 : Masai Mara – Nairobi. End of a memorable tour. Depart and Fly back or onwards.
