## Day 1 : Welcome to Hanoi – Capital of Vietnam.

Welcome to Hanoi – Capital of Vietnam known for its centuries-old architecture and a rich culture. On arrival, proceed to your conveniently located hotel (Check-in after 15:00). Rest of the day free to relax in the hotel. Overnight in Hanoi.

## Day 2 : Guided tour of Hanoi. Experience cyclo (rickshaw) ride.

Today take a full day tour of Hanoi's most interesting sights, including the Ho Chi Minh Complex and Stilts House, the Presidential Palace and the One Pillar Pagoda and, nearby, the Old Quarter also known as the 36 streets and guilds. Also on the tour, the Lake of the Restored Sword and Ngoc Son Temple, the Temple of Literature, peaceful West Lake (with lover's street Thanh Nien), the sedate Tran Quoc Pagoda and Quan Thanh Temple and one of the city's museums, either the History Museum or the Ethnology Museum. Experience cyclo (rickshaw) ride – an excellent way to experience Ha Noi at close hand as the atmosphere is lively, hectic, and sociable. Explore the fascinating maze of back streets, discover your bargaining power, and come away with unusual items that will always remind you of this memorable afternoon. Overnight in Hanoi.

## Day 3 : Hanoi – Halong Bay

We leave Hanoi and Proceed to Ha Long Bay, one of Vietnam's greatest natural wonders and was recognized as World's Natural Heritage by UNESCO. Take a cruise on the emerald green waters of Ha Long among the 3,000 spectacular limestone islands, visit grottoes Thien Cung & Dau Go. The cruise ends with a fresh lunch on board. Back to Hanoi after lunch time. Reach Hanoi in the late afternoon. Transfer to Noi Bai airport to take the flight to Danang. Upon arrival the airport, you will be greeted by your guide and transferred your hotel (Check-in after 15:00). Note: Cruise Itinerary is subject to change based on weather conditions. Overnight in Danang.

## Day 4 : Danang – Golden Bridge – Hoi An ancient town

Today, drive from your hotel to Ba Na Hill, a scenic mountainous area with panoramic vistas reminiscent. Standing more than 1,400 meters (4,878 feet) above sea level, the temperature of this place is mostly cool year-round. Arrive at Ba Na Hills cable car station, ride on a modern system of cable cars and get a bird's-eye view of nature which is strikingly beautiful. Experience the feeling of walking in the clouds when you walk on the Golden Bridge which seems to be supported by a pair of giant hands jutting out of the mountain. Then, enjoy your leisure time on Ba Na Hills for further activities such as European Architecture Villas, in-door game, French Wine Cellar, flower beds and pagoda. Take cable downhill, continue drive to visit famous Hoi An ancient town. Take a guided walking tour in the World Heritage Site by UNESCO – Hoi An Ancient town, which is recognized for its well-preserved architecture, pedestrian-only streets, old age tile-roofed shop houses, and typical local cuisine. ## Day 5 : Danang – Hoi An – Danang

Get ready to be transferred to Hoi An, which is a major Asian trading port in the 17th and 18th centuries and its architecture and relaxed lifestyle has changed little over the years. In the morning, visit Hoi An ancient town, the ancient architecture of Hoi An is a fascinating combination of Vietnamese traditional characters with Chinese and Japanese influence. There are plenty to see in this delightful town, some of which are the famous Japanese Covered Bridge, Trieu Chau Assembly house, 200 years old Tan Ky House & Historical Museum. Today we include these on a walking tour past many low tiled houses scattered along the small streets and assembly halls, which reflect the town's multi-cultural past. Then, proceed to Bach Dang dock. Take a wooden boat transferring to Cam Thanh water coconut village. Learn about the daily life of Vietnamese fishermen, their families and their community. Board on boat and commence cruising on the Cua Dai River. Overnight in Danang.

## Day 6 : Danang – Fly to Phu Quoc

Early morning transfer to Danang airport to take a morning flight to Phu Quoc Island. Upon arrival the airport, you will be greeted by your guide and proceed on a half day city tour visit and shopping at Pearl Farm experience the beauty and allure of pearls which across centuries and cultures have long been associated with wealth, royalty and glamour. You can find out procedures of pearl production. Visit local Pepper Farm and meet who introduce about the harvesting of pepper. Then, visit Sim Wine Factory where fruit wine is made from the berries of the myrtle tree that grows here. You can explore the sim garden and then showed, where they make the wine.

## Day 9 : Ho Chi Minh City – Cu Chi tunnels

Start the day with a drive to visit Cu Chi tunnels - At its height, the tunnel system stretched over 250km. from Saigon to the Cambodian border and was three levels deep. The network included innumerable trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centers and kitchens. Today the remaining tunnels have become a major tourist attraction giving the visitor a unique experience and a feel of what underground life during the U.S.-Vietnam American must have been like.
